- Support and monitor accreditation of training partners, training of trainers, and training programs.
- Initiate collaborations with various state governments, semi-government bodies, and related institutions to drive skill development projects.
- Develop and promote skilling initiatives in collaboration with **NSDC/MSDE**.
- Ensure compliance with all statutory requirements of Central/State governments and other relevant bodies, including timely audits.
- Maintain IESC offices with adequate staffing, and ensure timely management of accounts payable and receivable.
- Organize periodic **Governing Council Meetings** and **AGMs** as per the Council's charter.
- Formulate financial business plans and take overall responsibility for the **Balance Sheet** and **Profit & Loss (P&L)** of the Council.
